## Position Summary

The Gas Utility Operator is responsible for the safe construction, operation, maintenance, inspection, and repair of Dinosaur Gas Co-op's natural gas distribution infrastructure. This role supports the ongoing integrity and reliability of the gas system while ensuring compliance with applicable safety standards, operating procedures, and regulatory requirements. The successful candidate will work closely with management and staff to support safe operations, emergency response, system maintenance, and positive member relations.

## Key Responsibilities

- Install, repair, and maintain natural gas distribution mains, services, and meters
- Perform butt fusion, electrofusion, and mechanical fitting installations
- Conduct pressure testing and air testing on new installations
- Build and install meter sets to code
- Inspect, maintain, and rebuild block valves, regulators, and intermediate stations
- Perform Pressure Factor Measurement testing and annual pressure checks
- Conduct station inspections, alarm testing, and station maintenance
- Complete meter exchanges as outlined by Measurement Canada
- Locate low and high-pressure gas lines for Alberta One Call requests
- Perform leak detection and corrective actions as required
- Respond to odorant complaints, carbon monoxide calls, and gas leaks
